The Fairport Harbor Police Department needs your help. We would like you to CALL THE POLICE WHEN YOU THINK SOMETHING IS WRONG.

Understand that your interpretation that an activity is suspicious is in and of itself enough to call the police. There could be and many times there are reasonable explanations for seemingly suspicious activities.

If you think or feel something is wrong or suspicious, it probably is. If you are in doubt CALL THE POLICE.

You will not be in trouble if you are wrong about suspicious activity. You are not "bothering" us when you call. It is our job to investigate your belief of suspicious activity.

You should call the police ANY TIME and EVERY TIME you suspect that something is wrong, suspicious, dangerous, criminal or possible trouble has occurred, is occurring, or is about to occur.

We do ^{not} maintain a dispatcher at the Village Hall. You must call 9-1-1 or 440-354-3434. CALL IMMEDIATELY. It does no good to notify the police department about suspicious activity the next day, next week or next month. We have officers on duty 24 hours per day, 7 days per week to answer your calls.
