GENERAL LABOR

Classification

Department

Service Department

Definition

Manual work assisting in the operations of the Service Department projects; all other related work as required.

Supervision

1. Works under the direct supervision of the Working Foreman or the assigned supervisor.

Job Environment

- 1. Work is generally performed outdoors under variable weather conditions, near hazards associated with construction sites; when performing water and sewer related work, with health risks associated with working near water and sewer flows.
- 2. Operates a variety of vehicles, including light duty trucks, medium duty trucks and highway snow plowing equipment; also operates a variety of hand and power tools, including jackhammers and vibratory equipment.
- 3. Makes contact with other Village Departments, and the public.
- 4. Errors could result in delay of service, and personal injury to self and/or others, damage to equipment, and danger to public safety and health.

Essential Functions

1. General labor may perform some or all of the following General Functions, as well as the function specific to the departments to which they are assigned.

General Functions

- 1. Mows grass; trims shrubs, rakes and seeds. Performs maintenance on equipment used.
- 2. Plows roads and sidewalks using trucks, tracked vehicles, and shovels.
- Performs building custodial functions and duties, lifts manhole covers, assists
 operators in rebuilding/repairing pumps, motors, as well as general equipment
 maintenance

Streets/Roads

1. Performs manual labor in the construction and maintenance of roadways and sidewalks, including raking, tamping, and rolling blacktop; operates jackhammer.

- 2. Paints traffic markings, including crosswalks, parking spaces, school signs, repairs signage.
- 3. Operates chain saw and similar or related equipment as the work situation dictates.

Water

- 1. Performs manual work in the maintenance of the municipal water system, including assisting in the laying, adjusting, sealing of water pipes and their connections; flushing fire hydrants; and other general water system maintenance
- 2. Performs similar or related work as the situation dictates.

Recommended Minimum Qualifications

Education and Experience

1. High school diploma or equivalency; or any equivalent of education and experience.

Knowledge, Ability and Skill

- 1. Working knowledge of the hazards and safety precautions involved in the work performed. Ability to understand and follow oral instructions; ability to operate hand tools, such as power lawn mowers, tampers, jackhammers and similar equipment.
- 2. For water and sewer related work, some knowledge of the practices, materials, tools, and equipment commonly used in the construction, repair and maintenance of sewers and drains.
- For street-repair work, some knowledge of the practices, materials, tools and equipment commonly used in the construction, repair, and maintenance of roads and sidewalks.
- 4. Maintain a valid Ohio Commercial Driver's License.

Physical Requirements

- 1. Moderate to strenuous physical effort generally required, including lifting routinely to fifty (50) pounds and occasionally in excess of sixty (60) pounds, twisting, walking, exposure to extremes of outdoor work.
- 2. Eyesight and hearing at or correctable to "normal ranges".
